Today we would like to re-introduce, you to three programs which have partnered with us to help lower crime and maintain vigilance in the face of terrorist threats.

Crime Stoppers and We Tip are both devoted to providing a safe and anonymous way to report crime, offers a cash reward to anyone providing information leading to an arrest, and works with law enforcement and the media to educate the community on how to report crimes. We Tip is similarly anonymous, and offers a way to report crimes ranging from violent crime to welfare fraud, food stamp fraud, and food stamp trafficking. If you have information about a crime and are hesitant to report it, please know that you can reach out to these organizations and help make the community safer for everyone.

iWatch is a community awareness program created to educate the public about behaviors and activities that may have a connection to terrorism. For more information about iWatch and which behaviors and activities you should report, log in to iWATCHLA.ORG.
