Hit and Run Vehicle Sought

On March 14, 2015, at approximately 6:20 p.m., a severe injury vehicle vs. pedestrian hit and run traffic collision occurred on Ganahl Street and Thornton Street in the Hollenbeck Area. The collision occurred when the 7 year old boy ran northbound across Ganahl Street and a vehicle traveling westbound struck him causing severe injury. The driver sped from the scene and failed to identify himself or render aid to the boy.

According to witnesses the suspect was driving a white car, possibly a Subaru or Saturn with 4 doors, and a spoiler on the trunk. The driver was described as a male with long hair or possibly a female dressed as a male. The boy was transported to LAC+USC Medical Center by paramedics from LAFD. He suffered trauma to his face and head with a fracture on his right leg.
