CURRENT CRIME TRENDS

Basic Car 16A81, Saticoy north to the 5 Freeway and the 170 Freeway east to the border of Burbank. Crime is up approximately 5% in Foothill. In the area of Basic Car 16A81, crime is up approximately 1.2%. The aggravated assaults are almost 50% higher than last year. Burglary-from-motor-vehicle crimes are up for property offenses.

Aggravated assaults did increase but the up-side is that a suspect is in custody in over half the cases. But in order to not become a victim, remember last months' article and keep out tempers down by being the stronger person and walking away.

Most of the burglary-from-motor-vehicles were unlocked doors and windows rolled down. There have also been cases of items removed from the truck bed. I know it is hot, but make the effort to not become a victim. As for homes being broken into, there was one in which the door was pried open and video games were taken. If you are going to be gone for an extended amount of time, lock up these items. No burglar wants to return to a home were there isn't anything good to take because most of it was locked up!

School is going to start. Encourage your child to be safe when walking to and from school, utilizing the crosswalks and signals. Additionally, teach them to be aware of their surroundings.
