Crime Stoppers and WeTip are devoted to providing a safe and anonymous way to report crime. Crime Stoppers offers a cash reward to anyone providing information leading to an arrest. We Tip is similarly anonymous, and offers a way to report crimes ranging from violent crime, welfare fraud, food stamp fraud, and food stamp trafficking. If you have information on a crime and are hesitant to report it, please know that you can reach out to these organizations and help make the community safer for everyone.

iWatch LA is a community awareness program created to educate the public about behaviors and activities that may have a connection to terrorism. More information about iWatch LA and which behaviors and activities you should report are available at [iWATCHLA.ORG](http://iWATCHLA.ORG).

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Q: What number do I call to submit a tip?**  
A: 800-222-TIPS (8477)

**Q: When can I submit a tip?**

A: You may submit an anonymous tip anytime, anywhere, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, by phone, text, or through the Internet.

**Q: What types of Crime tips should be submitted?**

A: Crime Stoppers wants information on crimes that have occurred including unsolved crimes. If a crime is in progress, please dial 9-1-1.

**Q: Will it cost me to send a text tip?**

A: Crime Stoppers requires no fee to participate. However, standard messaging rates and other fees may apply. Check with your phone company for more details.

**Q: What do I do if I have problems texting my tip?**

A: If you have problems texting your tip from your mobile phone, send a text message with the word "HELP" to 274637 (CRIMES) for program information. This is information for phone problems only. Do not solicit law enforcement help from this number, instead call 911 for emergencies.

**Q: Can I use Crime Stoppers if I am a victim of a crime?**

A: No. If you are a victim of a crime, please immediately report it to your nearest police or Sheriff's station.
